What does Double Degree mean?

Double Degree Program offers a special facility for students to get two degrees at the same time and to be able to study two semesters at the partner university, if they fulfill the credit and diploma requirements separately.

What is offered in the program?

Students do not have to pay tuition fees in the host universities, because the home institutions ensure the payment. The home universities acknowledge all credits that are gained in the host universities. Students get two diplomas at the same time, one from the home university and another from the host partner institution.

Who can join to the Double Degree Program?

For now, students who studies international economy on BA level and obtained at least 90 credits can participate in the program. Other requirements are the intermediate or advanced level English language skills, active student status and active participation in supporting foreign students who study at the faculty.

What kind of tasks do the students have?

- Students have to fulfill two semesters at the partner university and they have to obtain 30 credits per semester.
- Students have to write their thesis in English and they have to defend it in English, too. The students have to choose two consultants, one from the home and another from the host universities.
- The cost of living, accommodation, travel, textbooks have to be provided by students, in which Erasmus scholarship can be helpful for a semester.
